Call for Applications - Membership of the Scientific, Technical and Economic Committee for Fisheries (STECF)

Q) What level of commitment does the STECF membership imply (e.g how many meetings per year can be expected, how many working days per year)?

A) Members of the STECF are required to contribute to the overall work programme of the STECF and to participate in plenary meetings (3 per year) and relevant Expert Working Groups EWGs as appropriate. Q) What is the type and volume of remuneration (reimbursement/daily allowance etc)?

Q) Is the function of a STECF member compatible with maintaining a position at my own research institute?

A) Yes, it is. But please bear in mind that STECF members are appointed in personal capacity as independent experts, not as representatives of the institutions they are affiliated to, nor as representatives of Member States. STECF members shall commit to act independently and in the public interest.

Q) Can an expert be nominated his/her organization?
